### SETUP



Give each player a pen and paper.



Decide final score or number of rounds. Assign a scorekeeper.



The player least likely to get into an argument starts. Turn order then proceeds clockwise.

### ROUND STRUCTURE



The player whose turn it is chooses a category, picks a card and reads the corresponding question aloud.



You can put a star next to <u>one</u> answer to earn bonus points.



All players list 5 answers each.



The round ends when the second-to-last player puts down their pen. Stop writing!

The first player to put the pen down reads their answers aloud, followed in clockwise order.



Note the scores and start a new round! When a player reaches the final score or when the rounds are up, the game ends.

### SCOREKEEPING

1


Each answer that is also present on any other player's list is awarded with one point.

Unless it is starred, then it's awarded with three points.

But! A starred answer not on any other player's list renders minus three points!

In each round, you can get a maximum of seven points (all answers in common with other players, one starred) and a minimum of minus three points (no answers in common, one starred).

## HOW TO MAKE LISTIT

Print the game on heavy, white card stock. Use a color printer for the best result.

Cut the cards up by using a paper slicer. Or just use your scissorhands if your name is Edward. Attention to detail is key here, you don't want to make a mess.

Find a nice box to keep the cards safe. Metal, plastic, cardboard... be creative! We've found nice rectangular boxes that can fit two decks of cards side by side, but you can surely find even better ways to safekeep your deck!
